2 **Prince George's County - Public School Facilities - Surcharge**

5 be used for certain purposes in the legislative district in which a building permit
6 for new residential construction is issued; and generally relating to the school
7 facilities surcharge.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

26 **Article 17 - Prince George's County**

2 (a) (1) The County Council, by ordinance, shall impose a school facilities
3 surcharge on new residential construction for which a building permit is issued on or
4 after July 1, 2003.

5 (2) (A) Except as provided under subparagraph (B) of this
6 paragraph, the County Council may impose a school facilities surcharge on new
7 residential construction for which a building permit is issued on or after July 1, 2003,
8 by a municipal corporation in Prince George's County with zoning authority and the
9 authority to issue building permits.

10 (B) The County Council may not impose a school facilities
11 surcharge on new residential construction for which a building permit is issued by a
12 municipal corporation if Prince George's County has collected a surcharge on issuance
13 of a County permit for the same new residential construction.

14 (e) Revenue collected under the school facilities surcharge shall be deposited
15 in a separate account and may only be used to pay for:

16 (1) Additional or expanded public school facilities such as renovations
17 to existing school buildings or other systemic changes **IN THE LEGISLATIVE**
18 **DISTRICT IN WHICH THE BUILDING PERMIT IS ISSUED**; or

19 (2) Debt service on bonds issued for additional or expanded public
20 school facilities or new school construction **IN THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN**
21 **WHICH THE BUILDING PERMIT IS ISSUED**.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2009.
