1 (2) Employ a certified public accountant licensed to practice in this 2 State to audit the books and accounts of the WSSC;

3 (3) Keep available and open to public inspection during business 4 hours, at its principal office, the annual audit and current financial statements; and

5 (4) File annually with the County Executive and County Council of 6 Prince George's County [and], the County Executive of Montgomery County, AND THE 7 MONTGOMERY COUNTY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SENATE AND HOUSE 8 DELEGATIONS TO THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY, a certified copy of the 9 annual audit and current financial statements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2009.
