4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to develop and implement a certain uniform statewide transportation system for 5 6 certain Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients; requiring the 7 transportation system to be operated by a single entity that responds directly to 8 the Department; requiring the Department to select an entity to operate the 9 transportation system through a competitive bid process on or before a certain 10 date; requiring the Department to use funds generated from efficiencies 11 resulting from the creation of the transportation system for certain purposes; and generally relating to transportation for Maryland Medical Assistance 12 Program recipients. 13

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
- 17 Health and Mental Hygiene shall use any funds generated from efficiencies resulting
- 18 from the creation of a statewide uniform transportation system under this Act for:
- 19 (a) raising reimbursement to nursing homes under the Maryland Medical
- 20 Assistance Program; and
- 21 (b) raising the level of funding to local health departments.
