12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LIFE CYCLE ASSESSMENT" MEANS A PROCESS TO 17 EVALUATE THE EFFECTS THAT A PRODUCT, SERVICE, OR STRUCTURE HAS ON 18 THE ENVIRONMENT OVER THE ENTIRE PERIOD OF ITS LIFE.
