- 4 (B) "ELIGIBLE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT" MEANS EMPLOYMENT IN THE

- 5 (4) AGREES TO PRACTICE IN AN ELIGIBLE PLACE OF 6 EMPLOYMENT FOR:
- 7 (I) AT LEAST 4 YEARS IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS LICENSED AS 8 A NURSE; OR

- 1 (A) THE OFFICE OF STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SHALL ADOPT 2 REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH:
- 3 (1) THAT PRIORITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM SHALL
- 4 BE GIVEN TO INDIVIDUALS WHO:
- 5 (I) GRADUATED FROM AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
- 6 EDUCATION IN THE LAST 3 YEARS; AND
- 7 (II) ARE RESIDENTS OF THE STATE;
- 8 (2) A PROCEDURE AND SCHEDULE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE
