13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTORIZED
 18 VEHICLE THAT:
 - 19 (1) IS DESIGNED TO TRAVEL OFF-HIGHWAY;
 - 20 (2) IS DESIGNED TO TRAVEL ON THREE OR FOUR LOW-PRESSURE 21 TIRES;
 - EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

(3) HAS A SEAT DESIGNED TO BE STRADDLED BY THE OPERATOR;
 (4) HAS HANDLEBARS FOR STEERING CONTROL; AND
 (5) IS INTENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER FOR USE BY A SINGLE OPERATOR OR AN OPERATOR AND ONE PASSENGER.

5 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT OPERATE OR RIDE ON AN ALL-TERRAIN 6 VEHICLE UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL IS WEARING PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR AND AN 7 EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICE THAT MEET THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE 8 ADMINISTRATOR FOR MOTORCYCLE HELMETS AND EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICES 9 UNDER § 21–1306 OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
