2	Correctional Services - Division of Correction Ambulance Service

3 FOR the purpose of establishing an ambulance service within the Division of Correction; requiring a correctional facility to use the ambulance service for an 4 5 emergency requiring transportation of an inmate by ambulance; providing that the costs of the ambulance service be paid from funds appropriated to the 6 7 Division in the State budget; requiring the Commissioner of Correction to determine the personnel and equipment needs, service area, and maintenance 8 9 and storage needs of the ambulance service; requiring the Commissioner to adopt regulations to carry out the requirements of this Act; defining certain 10 terms; and generally relating to an ambulance service in the Division of 11 Correction. 12
