- areas, and any other lands under its control. The rules and regulations shall be posted in conspicuous places upon the lands and enforced by the forest and park officers.
 - (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT MANDATE ACCESS TO SOME PORTION OF ALL STATE PARKS BY A PERSON ACCOMPANIED BY A PET.
