A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland State Parks – Pet Access**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to adopt certain
4 rules and regulations mandating access to some portion of State parks by a
5 person accompanied by a pet; and generally relating to pet access to State
6 parks.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Natural Resources**

20 5–209.

21 (a) The Department may make rules and regulations for the maintenance of
22 order, safety, sanitation, traffic control, or for the protection of trees and other
23 property and the preservation of the natural beauty within the State parks and
24 forests, State reserves, scenic preserves, parkways, historical monuments, recreational

1 areas, and any other lands under its control. The rules and regulations shall be posted
2 in conspicuous places upon the lands and enforced by the forest and park officers.

3 **(F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT**
4 **MANDATE ACCESS TO SOME PORTION OF ALL STATE PARKS BY A PERSON**
5 **ACCOMPANIED BY A PET.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2009.
