A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – State Song For Children – “The Land Mary-land”**

3 FOR the purpose of designating “The Land Mary-land” as the State song for children.

4 BY adding to

5 Article – State Government

6 Section 13–307.1

7 Annotated Code of Maryland

8 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

9 Preamble

10 WHEREAS, The current State song, “Maryland, My Maryland” by James Ryder
11 Randall, is of historical interest; and

12 WHEREAS, The complex lyrics of “Maryland, My Maryland” reflect the turmoil
13 of the period during which the song was written; and

14 WHEREAS, It would be fitting to have a contemporary State song that is
15 singable for school children as well as the citizenry at large; and

16 WHEREAS, Tom Wisner’s song, “The Land Mary-land”, captures the spirit,
17 dreams, and hopes of the early settlers of the State; and

18 WHEREAS, “The Land Mary-land” is especially appropriate for a State song for
19 children because it focuses on the idealism of the settlers who founded the State, the
20 importance of their dreams of freedom, and their commitment to tolerance; and

21 WHEREAS, Designation of “The Land Mary-land” as the State song for
22 children would be a fitting tribute to the composer, Tom Wisner, a man who has

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – State Government**

6 **13-307.1.**

14 **WE WILL CARRY OUR LONGING TO THE FAIR MARYLAND.**
