A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Funding Accountability Act**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain grantees that receive certain State aid to submit
4 a report to the Department of Budget and Management by a certain date;
5 requiring the report to contain certain information and be provided in a certain
6 form; requiring the Department to develop and operate a certain searchable
7 website providing certain information; authorizing the Office of Legislative
8 Audits to conduct certain audits of certain grantees that receive at least a
9 certain appropriation or grant in the operating or capital budget or from the
10 action of a unit of State government; requiring the Office of Legislative Audits
11 to identify for a certain audit a certain percentage of grantees each year;
12 defining certain terms; and generally providing for the reporting and auditing of
13 certain grantees receiving certain State aid.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **(II) EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE**
2 **AUDITS SHALL AUDIT OR REVIEW THE SPECIFIED PERCENTAGE OF GRANTEES**
3 **REQUIRED TO FILE A REPORT UNDER § 7-406 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND**
4 **PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 June 1, 2009.
