1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Not-For-Profit Development Center Program - Qualifying Not-For-Profit Entity Assistance

FOR the purpose of adding and amending certain defined terms under the Maryland
Not-For-Profit Development Center Program; requiring the Program to provide
certain support and assistance to qualifying not-for-profit entities; altering the
requirements for a certain designee of the Program; and generally relating to
the Maryland Not-For-Profit Development Center Program.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (C) "NOT-FOR-PROFIT ENTITY" MEANS A CORPORATION 2 INCORPORATED IN THE STATE, OR OTHERWISE QUALIFIED TO DO BUSINESS IN 3 THE STATE, THAT HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE INTERNAL REVENUE 4 SERVICE TO BE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER § 501(C)(3), (4), OR (6) OF THE 5 INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.
