#### 1 AN ACT concerning

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### Horse Racing - Purse Dedication Account - Allocation of Funds

- FOR the purpose of altering certain allocations of the Purse Dedication Account under 3 the authority of the State Racing Commission to be funded with certain video 4 lottery proceeds; requiring that funds in the Account be allocated in a certain 5 6 thoroughbred purses at certain race Maryland-bred Race Fund, standardbred purses at certain race tracks, and the 7 8 Standardbred Race Fund; and generally relating to the Purse Dedication 9 Account under the authority of the State Racing Commission.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 4 5	(a) On a properly approved transmittal prepared by the Commission, the Comptroller shall pay the following amounts from the proceeds of video lottery terminals at each video lottery facility:
$\frac{6}{7}$	(4) 7% to the Purse Dedication Account established under $\S 9-1A-28$ of this subtitle, not to exceed a total of \$100,000,000 to the Account annually;
8	9–1A–28.
9 10	(a) There is a Purse Dedication Account under the authority of the State Racing Commission.
11 12	(b) (1) The Account shall receive money as required under $\S$ 9–1A–27 of this subtitle.
13 14	(c) Subject to subsections (d) and (e) of this section, the State Racing Commission shall allocate funds in the Account as follows:
15	(1) 80% to the thoroughbred industry; and
16	(2) 20% to the standardbred industry.
17 18	(d) The amount of funds allocated to thoroughbred purses and the Maryland-bred Race Fund shall be allocated as follows:
19 20	(1) [85%] <b>89</b> % to thoroughbred purses at the Pimlico Race Course, Laurel Park, the racecourse in Allegany County, and the racecourse at Timonium; and
21	(2) [15%] 11% to the Maryland–bred Race Fund.
22 23	(e) The amount of funds allocated to standardbred purses and the Standardbred Race Fund shall be allocated as follows:
24 25 26	(1) [85%] <b>89</b> % to standardbred purses at Rosecroft Raceway, Ocean Downs Race Course, and the racecourse in Allegany County, allocated based on the number of live racing days at each track location; and
27	(2) [15%] 11% to the Standardbred Race Fund.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 29 October 1, 2009.
