25	effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or		
26	compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County shall take effect at the beginning of		
27	the next following term of office.		
28	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect		
29	October 1, 2009.
