1 AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Lawful Presence - Identification Card, Moped Operator's Permit, or Driver's License

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for an identification card, moped operator's permit, or driver's license issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide 5 documentation acceptable to the Administration that the applicant is a United 6 7 States citizen or is lawfully present in the United States in accordance with 8 federal law; providing for the effective term of an identification card, moped operator's permit, or driver's license issued to certain applicants; requiring the 9 Administration to issue an identification card, moped operator's permit, or 10 driver's license, with certain distinguishing features, to an applicant who is 11 otherwise eligible for the identification card, moped operator's permit, or 12 13 driver's license, but who does not provide certain documentation that the applicant is a United States citizen or is lawfully present in the United States in 14 accordance with federal law; clarifying language; and generally relating to the 15issuance of an identification card, moped operator's permit, or driver's license 16 17and lawful presence in the United States.
