### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

## Electricity – Provision of Electricity Supply to Units of State Government and Local Governments

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of General Services to procure a certain 5 electricity supply on behalf of certain units of State government and certain 6 counties and municipal corporations; requiring the Department to procure a 7 certain electricity supply through competitive sealed proposals under certain circumstances; requiring the Department, after consulting with the Public 8 9 Service Commission and the Maryland Energy Administration, to adopt certain 10 regulations under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to report to 11 the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; defining a certain term; providing that existing obligations or contract rights 12 may not be impaired by this Act; and generally relating to the procurement of 13 14 electricity for units of State government and local governments.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# 24(A) IN THIS SECTION, "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF25GENERAL SERVICES.

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1 (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE DEPARTMENT 2 SHALL PROCURE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ON BEHALF OF ALL UNITS OF STATE 3 GOVERNMENT.

4 (2) ON REQUEST OF ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION 5 AND IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROCUREMENT OF ELECTRICITY UNDER 6 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROCURE 7 ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL 8 CORPORATION.

9 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING § 7–510 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT 10 SHALL PROCURE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY THROUGH COMPETITIVE SEALED 11 PROPOSALS UNDER § 13–104 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT 12 ARTICLE.

(D) THE DEPARTMENT, AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE COMMISSION
AND THE MARYLAND ENERGY ADMINISTRATION, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS
TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS THAT:

16 (1) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTRACTING FOR THE PURCHASE OF 17 ELECTRICITY, DIVIDE THE STATE INTO REGIONS THAT MAY GENERALLY 18 FOLLOW THE SERVICE TERRITORIES OF ELECTRIC COMPANIES THAT OPERATE 19 IN THE STATE;

(2) DETERMINE A STRATEGY OF HOW BEST TO STRUCTURE
PROCUREMENT IN SUCH A WAY AS TO MEET THE ELECTRICITY DEMANDS IN A
COST-EFFECTIVE MANNER, INCLUDING ENTERING INTO SUPPLY CONTRACTS OF
SHORT, MEDIUM, AND LONG TERMS; AND

24(3) ESTABLISH A PREFERENCE SYSTEM FOR ELECTRICITY25GENERATED FROM RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES IN THE STATE.

(E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT
SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF
THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY REGARDING THE
PROCUREMENT OF ELECTRICITY UNDER THIS SECTION.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing 31 obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 October 1, 2009.
