BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 Article - Natural Resources 16 10–410. 17 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a 18 person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays. The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and 19 (2)mammals on Sundays: 20 21 A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds or (i) 22 mammals during open season;
