| 15 16 | SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: |

| 19 20 | (a) (1) The Commission shall adopt regulations setting standards for the assessment of fines under \S 9–664 of this Part IX of this subtitle. |
| 21 | (2) The Commission may adopt regulations about: |
| 22 23 | (i) the provision of medicine and medical, nursing, and hospital services to a covered employee; |
