18 19 20 21 22 23	(f) In addition to the exemptions provided in subsection (b) of this section, and in other statutes of this State, in any proceeding under Title 11 of the United States Code, entitled "Bankruptcy", any individual debtor domiciled in this State may exempt the debtor's aggregate [interest] INTERESTS, not to exceed \$5,000 in value[,] in real property [or personal property] AND NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000 IN VALUE IN PERSONAL PROPERTY.
