14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

vehicle inspected and tested as required under this subtitle.

1 maximum gross weight up to and including 26,000 pounds, shall have the vehicle 2 inspected and tested as required under this subtitle.

- 3 (D) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO A VEHICLE THAT IS REQUIRED
 4 TO BE INSPECTED AND TESTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- 5 (2) ON TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP, A VEHICLE THAT HAS BEEN IN 6 OPERATION FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS FROM THE VEHICLE'S MODEL YEAR OR 7 FIRST REGISTRATION DATE, WHICHEVER IS LATER, SHALL BE INSPECTED AND 8 TESTED AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE WITHIN 10 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER 9 THE TRANSFER.

10(3) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO11ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2009.
