## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – State’s Attorney – Annual Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the annual salary of the State’s Attorney for Frederick  
4 County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of  
5 the incumbent State’s Attorney; and generally relating to the State’s Attorney  
6 for Frederick County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article – Criminal Procedure

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

1 (a) This section applies only in Frederick County.

2 (b) (1) The State’s Attorney’s annual salary is equal to the salary of a  
3 [judge of the District Court of Maryland] **CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
5 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
6 the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney for Frederick County in office on  
7 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or  
8 compensation of the State’s Attorney for Frederick County shall take effect at the  
9 beginning of the next following term of office.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 October 1, 2009.
