BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 11 12**Article – Election Law** 13 8-201. 14 (a) (1)There shall be a statewide primary election in every 15even-numbered year. 16 (2)A primary election shall be held: 17(i) in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the second 18 Tuesday after the first Monday in [September] JUNE; and 19 in the year in which the President of the United States is (ii) 20elected, on the second Tuesday in February.

1 (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices 2 on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year following 3 the election of the Governor.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2009.
