$\frac{24}{25}$	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

- 2 5–101.
- 3 (a) (1) A Class A beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license 4 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The holder of 5 the license may keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail, in any quantity to 6 any consumers, at the place described in the license. The holder shall deliver the beer 7 and light wines in a sealed package or container, which package or container may not 8 be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold.
- 9 (q) (1) In Montgomery County the annual license fee is \$250.
- 10 (4) A SUPERMARKET LOCATED IN THE ROCKVILLE TOWN 11 CENTER ZONED PROPERTY MAY BE ISSUED A CLASS A BEER AND LIGHT WINE 12 LICENSE.
- 13 9–102.
- 14 (a-1) (1) A Class A, B, or D beer license, beer and wine license, or beer, wine 15 and liquor license, except by way of renewal, may not be granted, transferred, or 16 issued to, or for use in conjunction with, or upon the premises of any business 17 establishment of the type commonly known as chain stores, supermarkets, or discount 18 houses.
- 19 **(2)** This subsection does not apply to or affect:
- 20 (I) [any] **ANY** business establishment already holding such a license or the possibility of such licensee having the license transferred to a similar type of business establishment; **OR**
- 23 (II) A SUPERMARKET UNDER  $\S$  5–101(Q)(4) OF THIS 24 ARTICLE.
- 25 (3) Discount houses do not include licensees who sell at discount 26 prices.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 July 1, 2009.
