## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## **Natural Resources - Somers Cove Marina Commission**

FOR the purpose of including the Somers Cove Marina Commission as State personnel 3 under the Maryland Tort Claims Act; specifying that Commission members who 4 5 are not employees of the Department of Natural Resources may use certain 6 vehicles and equipment under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department to transfer vehicles and other inventory to the Commission under 7 8 certain circumstances; authorizing the Executive Director of the Commission to 9 engage in emergency procurement under certain circumstances; requiring the Executive Director to submit a report to the Commission including certain 10 information after use of the emergency procurement procedure; providing for 11 the application of certain provisions relating to the purchase of items for direct 12 resale or remanufacture; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally 13 14 relating to the Somers Cove Marina Commission.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
