A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2007 – Martin Luther King, Jr.,**
3 **National Memorial Project**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2007
5 to provide that the Department of the Interior may not be required to become a
6 party to the grant agreement for the Martin Luther King, Jr., National
7 Memorial Project; and generally relating to the Maryland Consolidated Capital
8 Bond Loan of 2007 and the grant for the Martin Luther King, Jr., National
9 Memorial Project.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 488 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2007
12 Section 1(3) Item ZA01(C) and ZA02(D)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
