2 **Juvenile Services - Employee Criminal History Record Information - *Initial***  
3 ***Criminal History Records Check and Disclosure of New Information***

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Criminal Justice Information System Central  
5 Repository to provide to the Department of Juvenile Services and ~~the employee~~  
6 ~~any changes in the employee's criminal history after the initial criminal history~~  
7 ~~records check~~ an employee of the Department a revised printed statement of the  
8 employee's criminal history record information under certain circumstances;  
9 altering the time within which the Department is required to apply for an initial  
10 criminal history records check for an employee; and generally relating to juvenile  
11 services.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article - Human Services**

7 9-209.

8 (a) (1) ~~Within the first month~~ **ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY** of  
 9 employment with the Department, the Department shall apply to the Criminal Justice  
 10 Information System Central Repository in the Department of Public Safety and  
 11 Correctional Services for a federal and State criminal history records check for each  
 12 employee of the Department.

13 (2) The Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository shall  
 14 provide the requested information in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the  
 15 Criminal Procedure Article.

16 (3) **IF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION IS REPORTED**  
 17 **TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY**  
 18 **AFTER THE DATE OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK, THE CRIMINAL**  
 19 **JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL PROVIDE TO**  
 20 **THE DEPARTMENT AND THE EMPLOYEE A REVISED PRINTED STATEMENT OF**  
 21 **THE EMPLOYEE'S CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 23 October 1, 2009.
