A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commissioner of Labor and Industry – Training of Power Equipment**
3 **Operators**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain rule of construction that relates to the
5 licensing, registration, or certification of an operator of power equipment; and
6 generally relating to the training of power equipment operators.

7 BY repealing

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Labor and Employment**

15 [5–504.

16 This subtitle may not be construed to allow or require licensing, registration, or
17 certification of an operator of power equipment.]

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2009.
