AN ACT concerning 1

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Agricultural Land Preservation - Condemnation of Land Under Easement

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain law does not prohibit certain governmental agencies from condemning land subject to certain agricultural 4 5 land preservation programs for certain purposes, subject to approval by the Board of Public Works after review and recommendation of the Maryland 6 7 Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation; requiring the condemning authority to meet certain requirements; and generally relating to condemnation 8 9 of land under easement to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation 10 Foundation.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17

- 20 (a) **(1)** [This] SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF 21 THIS SUBSECTION, THIS subtitle does not prohibit an agency of the State or of a 22county OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY from acquiring by condemnation land which is under an agricultural preservation easement held by the Foundation or 23 24 a county agricultural land preservation program if such acquisition is for a public

1	(2) (I) IF THE PURPOSE OF THE CONDEMNATION OF LAND
2	UNDER A FOUNDATION EASEMENT IS EITHER FOR ECONOMIC OR RESIDENTIAL
3	DEVELOPMENT OR PARKLAND, THE ACQUISITION OF THE LAND SHALL BE
4	SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AFTER REVIEW AND
5	RECOMMENDATION OF THE FOUNDATION.
6	(II) THE CONDEMNING AUTHORITY SHALL DEMONSTRATE
7	THAT:
8	1. A GREATER PUBLIC PURPOSE EXISTS THAN THAT
9	SERVED BY THE FOUNDATION EASEMENT; AND
10	2. THERE IS NO REASONABLE ALTERNATIVE SITE.
11	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12	October 1, 2009.
