17 18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

"Law enforcement agency" means an agency that is listed in § 3-1 (2) $\mathbf{2}$ 101(e) of the Public Safety Article and that, in accordance with subsection (c) of this 3 section, is subject to the provisions of this section. 4 (3)"Law enforcement officer" means any person who, in an official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is an employee of a law 5 enforcement agency that is subject to this section. 6 7 "Maryland Justice Analysis Center" means the center operated by 8 the Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice at the University of Maryland, 9 College Park. 10 (5)"Police Training Commission" means the unit within the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services established under § 3-202 of 11 the Public Safety Article. 12 13 (6)Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, "traffic stop" (i) 14 means any instance when a law enforcement officer stops the driver of a motor vehicle and detains the driver for any period of time for a violation of the Maryland Vehicle 15 16 Law. "Traffic stop" does not include: 17 (ii) 18 1. A checkpoint or roadblock stop; A stop of multiple vehicles due to a traffic accident or 19 2. emergency situation requiring the stopping of vehicles for public safety purposes; or 20 21A stop based on the use of radar, laser, [or] vascar, 3. 22OR AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM technology. Each time a law enforcement officer makes a traffic stop, that officer 23 shall report the following information to the law enforcement agency that employs the 24 25 officer using the format developed by the law enforcement agency under subsection 26 (b)(1) of this section: 27 The date, location, and the time of the stop; **(1)** 28 (2)The approximate duration of the stop; 29 (3)The traffic violation or violations alleged to have been committed 30 that led to the stop; 31 (4) Whether a search was conducted as a result of the stop;
