14 15	(iv) any private postsecondary vocational–technical or trade school that grants a member a tuition waiver of at least 50% .

17	(i) is regularly enlisted in the National Guard; or
18	(ii) holds a commission in the National Guard as:
19	1. an officer in the grade of major or below; or
20	2. a warrant officer.
21 22 23	(4) (i) "Tuition" means the basic instructional charge for undergraduate, GRADUATE, PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL, AND TRADE SCHOOL credit courses and related fees at an institution.
24 25	(ii) "Tuition" does not include charges for self–supporting programs.
26 27 28 29	(b) (1) To the extent that funds are provided in the State budget, the Department may provide assistance equal to 50% of the cost of in-State tuition for any regularly scheduled undergraduate credit course, GRADUATE CREDIT COURSE , PROFESSIONAL CREDIT COURSE , vocational-technical course, or trade course for
