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Recipients of Grants, Loans, or Financial Assistance - Reporting Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain entities that receive State financial assistance to 5 submit an annual report concerning utilization of minority business enterprises to the department or unit providing the financial assistance and the Governor's 6 7 Office of Minority Affairs; requiring certain reports to also be submitted to the Board of Public Works; and generally relating to reporting of the utilization of 8 9 minority business enterprises by entities receiving State financial assistance.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16

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Article - State Finance and Procurement

18 7-406.

19	(A) EACH ENTITY THAT RECEIVES A GRANT, LOAN, OR FINANCIAL
20	ASSISTANCE OF \$100,000 OR MORE FROM A DEPARTMENT OR UNIT FOR
21	CAPITAL PROJECTS SHALL, WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL
22	YEAR, SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OR UNIT AND THE GOVERNOR'S
23	OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.



1 (B) ALL REPORTS REGARDING GRANTS FUNDED BY THE PROCEEDS OF A 2 GENERAL OBLIGATION LOAN UNDER § 8–301 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL ALSO BE 3 SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

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4 (C) ALL REPORTS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

5 (1) STATE, FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR, THE TOTAL
NUMBER AND VALUE OF CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE ENTITY AND CERTIFIED
MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES WITH RESPECT TO EACH LOAN, GRANT, OR
8 OTHER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE RECEIVED;

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- (2) DETAIL MINORITY BUSINESS OUTREACH EFFORTS; AND

10(3) CONTAINOTHERRELATEDMINORITYBUSINESS11INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY12AFFAIRS.

13(D) ALL REPORTS SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE14GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.
