## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Interagency Committee on Aging Services – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of adding the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, the Director of the  
4 Governor’s Office of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, and the Chair of the  
5 Commission on Aging to the Interagency Committee on Aging Services; and  
6 generally relating to membership of the Interagency Committee on Aging  
7 Services.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Human Services  
10 Section 10–302  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2007 Volume and 2008 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Human Services**

16 10–302.

17 (a) The Interagency Committee consists of the following members:

18 (1) the Secretary of Aging;

19 (2) the Secretary of Disabilities;

20 (3) the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;

21 (4) the Secretary of Housing and Community Development;

- 5           **(9)    THE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF THE DEAF**  
6 **AND HARD OF HEARING;**
- 7           **(10) THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION ON AGING;**
- 8           [(8)] **(11)**   a representative from an area agency appointed by the  
9 Governor from a list submitted by the Maryland Association of Area Agencies on  
10 Aging; and
- 11           [(9)] **(12)**   a member of the public appointed by the Governor.
- 12           (b)    (1)    The term of a member appointed by the Governor under subsection  
13 [(a)(8) or (9)] **(A)(11) OR (12)** of this section is 2 years.
- 14           (2)    A member appointed by the Governor under subsection [(a)(8) or  
15 (9)] **(A)(11) OR (12)** of this section may not be reappointed for more than 2 additional  
16 terms.
- 17           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 2009.
