Prince George's County - Ammunition Sales to Minors - Penalties

3 **PG 324-09**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from selling, giving, or otherwise transferring, or attempting to sell, give, or otherwise transfer certain ammunition to a minor in Prince George's County; prohibiting a minor from purchasing or attempting to purchase certain ammunition or possessing ammunition in a public place; prohibiting a person from selling, giving, or otherwise transferring or attempting to sell, give, or otherwise transfer certain ammunition to an individual without first verifying, by certain means, that the individual is not a minor; requiring each person engaged in the business of selling certain ammunition to apply to the county health department for a certain registration, with a certain exception; requiring the registration to be on a certain form, contain certain information, and be supplemented within a certain period of any change of certain information; establishing certain registration fees; requiring each person engaged in the business of selling certain ammunition to post conspicuously in that person's place of business a certain notice and keep a certain log of ammunition sales; requiring that the sales log be kept in a certain location and made available for inspection by certain individuals; requiring the county health department to adopt certain regulations; providing penalties for a violation of this Act; defining certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the sale of ammunition to minors in Prince George's County.
