## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission – System Improvement Charges**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the properties for which the St. Mary's County  
4 Metropolitan Commission is required to impose and collect a certain per EDU  
5 system improvement charge; requiring the Commission to impose and collect a  
6 certain per EDU system improvement charge at the same time the EDU is  
7 allocated; and generally relating to a system improvement charge imposed by  
8 the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
10 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 19 – St. Mary's County**

22 113–29.

23 A. (1) In this section, the following words have the meanings indicated:

24 (2) EDU means an equivalent dwelling unit.

1                   (3)    PUBLICATION means notice to all persons having any interest in  
2 the property.

3            B.    (1)    For every property, whether improved or unimproved, binding on a  
4 street, road, lane, alley, right-of-way or easement [in which a Commission water  
5 distribution system or sewerage system has been built,] **FOR WHICH AN EDU HAS  
6 BEEN ALLOCATED BY THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY OFFICE OF LAND USE AND  
7 GROWTH MANAGEMENT**, the Commission shall impose and collect a per EDU  
8 system improvement charge [for every EDU allocated by the St. Mary's County Office  
9 of Land Use and Growth Management] **AT THE SAME TIME THE EDU IS  
10 ALLOCATED.**

11                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
12 October 1, 2009.
