A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages Inspectors – Firearms**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing an alcoholic beverages inspector in Frederick County
4 to carry a firearm in the performance of the inspector's duties and to issue a
5 certain citation under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic
6 beverages inspectors in Frederick County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Criminal Law**

15 10–119.

16 (b) A citation for a violation of §§ 10–113 through 10–118 of this part may be
17 issued by:

18 (3) (I) in Anne Arundel County, Frederick County, Harford County,
19 Montgomery County, and Prince George's County, and only in the inspector's
20 jurisdiction, an alcoholic beverages inspector who investigates license violations under
21 Article 2B of the Code if the inspector:

22 [(i)] 1. has successfully completed an appropriate program of
23 training in the proper use of arrest authority and pertinent police procedures as
24 required by the board of license commissioners; and

1 [(ii)] **2. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM (II) OF THIS ITEM,**
2 does not carry firearms in the performance of the inspector's duties; **AND**

3 **(II) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**
4 **INSPECTOR WHO CARRIES A FIREARM IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE**
5 **INSPECTOR'S DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2009.
