- FOR the purpose of establishing a Multivenue wine license in Frederick County;
 specifying that a holder of the license may hold simultaneous wine events at a
 certain number of venues that meet certain requirements; authorizing a holder
 of the license to sell wine and to allow a certain license holder to conduct a wine
 tasting under certain circumstances; requiring that a holder of the license
 prohibit a guest from transporting wine under certain circumstances; and

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 8–406.1 of Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages of the 23 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8–406.2.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 25 read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

2 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN FREDERICK COUNTY.

3 (B) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A 1-DAY
 4 MULTIVENUE WINE (MVW) (ON- AND OFF-SALE) LICENSE TO A BONA FIDE
 5 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

6 (C) A HOLDER OF AN MVW LICENSE MAY CONDUCT SIMULTANEOUS 7 WINE EVENTS AT NOT MORE THAN FIVE VENUES THAT ARE:

8 (1) WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE OF EACH OTHER; AND

9 (2) LOCATED IN DISTRICTS THAT ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION OF 10 WINE.

11 (D) UNDER REGULATIONS THAT THE BOARD OF LICENSE 12 COMMISSIONERS ADOPTS, A HOLDER OF AN MVW LICENSE AT EACH WINE 13 EVENT:

14(1) MAY SELL WINE BY THE GLASS FOR ON-PREMISES15CONSUMPTION OR BY THE BOTTLE FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION;

16 (2) MAY ALLOW A HOLDER OF A CLASS A LIGHT WINE LICENSE TO
 17 CONDUCT A WINE TASTING; AND

18 (3) SHALL PROHIBIT A GUEST FROM TRANSPORTING WINE FROM
 19 ONE VENUE TO ANOTHER.

20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 July 1, 2009.
