11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:
13 14	(a) The Office of Legislative Audits shall conduct a performance audit of the Computer–Assisted Mass Appraisal System as it relates to property tax assessments.
15	(b) The performance audit shall include:
16 17	(1) an evaluation of the efficiency, effectiveness, and economy of the Computer–Assisted Mass Appraisal System; and
18 19	(2) a determination of whether the Computer–Assisted Mass Appraisal System results in:

(c) On or before January 1, 2010, the Office of Legislative Audits shall report
to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government
Article, on the audit of the Computer-Assisted Mass Appraisal System.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2009. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
