- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THERE IS A PARTY PROMOTER'S LICENSE ISSUED BY THE 19 COMPTROLLER.
- 20 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL OBTAIN A PARTY PROMOTER'S LICENSE 21 BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY ORGANIZE OR HOLD A PARTY IN THE STATE AT 22 WHICH:
- 23 (1) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE TO BE SERVED OR CONSUMED;

7 8 9 10	(1) Ensure that an individual who has completed training in an alcohol awareness program under § 13–101 of this article is present during the hours in which alcohol is served of consumed; and
11 12 13 14	(2) PROVIDE ADEQUATE SECURITY FOR THE SAFETY OF INDIVIDUALS IN ATTENDANCE BY EMPLOYING A SECURITY GUARD AGENCY LICENSED UNDER TITLE 19, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.
