Health - Regulation and Permitting of Egg Sellers at Farmers' Markets

- FOR the purpose of making an exception to the authority of the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to regulate the distribution in the State of a certain food; requiring, for certain purposes, that a person selling eggs at a farmers' market be treated by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene or a local health department the same as if the person were selling the eggs from the farm on which the eggs were produced; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the regulation and permitting of egg producers selling eggs at farmers' markets.

- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 9 "RAW AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS" INCLUDES EGGS, GRAINS,
- 10 FLOWERS, FRUITS, AND VEGETABLES SUPPLIED DIRECTLY FROM THE FARM ON
- 11 WHICH THEY WERE PRODUCED.
- 12 (B) FOR PURPOSES OF REGULATION AND PERMITTING BY THE
- 13 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR A LOCAL HEALTH
- 14 DEPARTMENT, A PERSON SELLING EGGS AT A FARMERS' MARKET SHALL BE
- 15 TREATED THE SAME AS IF THE PERSON WERE SELLING THE EGGS ON THE FARM
- 16 AT WHICH THE EGGS WERE PRODUCED.
