1 (v) The County [Commissioners] **COUNCIL** shall approve the 2 salary of the chief deputy sheriff.

3 (3) (i) The Sheriff may appoint probationary deputy sheriffs, 4 deputy sheriffs, investigators, communications officers, secretaries, supervisors, 5 administrators, and other staff as approved in the county budget.

6 (ii) The County [Commissioners] **COUNCIL** shall approve the 7 salaries for all staff appointed by the Sheriff.

8 (iii) The Sheriff may not refuse to reappoint a deputy sheriff9 without just cause.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 11 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to 12 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Dorchester County in office on the effective 13 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of 14 the Sheriff of Dorchester County shall take effect at the beginning of the next 15 following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2009.
