16 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL A FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OR A 17 STATE FLAG IN THE STATE UNLESS IT IS MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED 18 STATES.

(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
 \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 60 DAYS OR BOTH.
