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Chapter 637 of the Acts of 2008

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 3 July 1, 2008. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June
 4 30, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
 5 abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 7 October 1, 2009.
