BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 17 5-301. 18 (b) 19 (1)For the purposes of this section other than subsection (c), the Board of Public Works shall define by regulation what constitutes an eligible and 20 21ineligible public school construction or capital improvement cost.

20	apply to the construction of new schools that have not initiated a Request for Proposal
21	for the selection of an architectural and engineering consultant on or before July 1,
22	2009.
23	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24	July 1, 2009.
