2 **Natural Resources – BayStat Subcabinet – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the BayStat Subcabinet to include a  
4 representative from the University of Maryland Biotechnology Institute; and  
5 generally relating to the membership of the BayStat Subcabinet.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article – Natural Resources  
8 Section 8–2A–03(a)(3)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2007 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Natural Resources**

14 8–2A–03.

15 (a) (3) The BayStat Subcabinet is composed of:

16 (i) The Secretary of Natural Resources;

17 (ii) The Secretary of the Environment;
