# FOR the purpose of allowing a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for certain contributions to certain education savings accounts, subject to certain limitations; providing for the application of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a Maryland income tax subtraction modification for certain contributions to family education savings accounts.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Tax – General

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1 (a) In addition to the modification under § 10–207 of this subtitle, the 2 amounts under this section are subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income of a 3 resident to determine Maryland adjusted gross income.

4 (Q) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "FAMILY EDUCATION SAVINGS 5 ACCOUNT" MEANS A COVERDELL EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT AS DEFINED 6 IN § 530 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

7 (2) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF 8 THIS SUBSECTION, THE SUBTRACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 9 INCLUDES THE AMOUNT CONTRIBUTED BY AN INDIVIDUAL DURING THE 10 TAXABLE YEAR TO A FAMILY EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT IN ACCORDANCE 11 WITH § 530 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

(3) (I) FOR ALL CONTRIBUTIONS TO FAMILY EDUCATION
 SAVINGS ACCOUNTS MADE BY AN INDIVIDUAL FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR, THE
 SUBTRACTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED, IN THE AGGREGATE,
 \$1,000 FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OR \$2,000 FOR A MARRIED COUPLE FILING A JOINT
 INCOME TAX RETURN.

17 (II) THE SUBTRACTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT
18 BE CLAIMED FOR ANY TAXABLE YEAR IN WHICH THE TAXPAYER CLAIMS A
19 SUBTRACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (N) OR (O) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 July 1, 2009, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31,
 2008.

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
