- 20 THE PURCHASER SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS 21 SECTION FOR 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.
- 22 A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 23 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100.
