Article – Transportation

16 6–103.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the Administration has
jurisdiction and may exercise its powers and duties in or near any of the navigable
waters of this State OR AT INLAND PROPERTIES OR FACILITIES ACQUIRED,
LEASED, OR OPERATED BY THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE TRANSPORT OR
STORAGE OF CARGO AND EQUIPMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2009.
