1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Port Administration – Jurisdiction, Powers, and Duties**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the Maryland Port Administration’s jurisdiction to
4 include certain inland properties or facilities; authorizing the Administration to
5 exercise its powers and duties at certain inland properties or facilities; and
6 generally relating to the jurisdiction, powers, and duties of the Maryland Port
7 Administration.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 6–103.

17 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the Administration has
18 jurisdiction and may exercise its powers and duties in or near any of the navigable
19 waters of this State **OR AT INLAND PROPERTIES OR FACILITIES ACQUIRED,**
