19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20	MADVI AND That the Laws of Manyland road as follows:

23 (A) **(1)** IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES AVAILABLE AT LAW OR 24 IN EQUITY AND AFTER AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING, THE FOUNDATION



- 1 MAY IMPOSE A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS
- 2 SUBTITLE, ANY REGULATION ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–504 OF THIS
- 3 SUBTITLE, OR AN EASEMENT ACQUIRED BY THE FOUNDATION.
- 4 (2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION OCCURS IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION 5 OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 (B) BEFORE TAKING ANY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE FOUNDATION SHALL PROVIDE THE ALLEGED VIOLATOR WITH WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR AN INFORMAL MEETING.
- 9 (C) The penalty imposed on a person under this section shall 10 BE:
- 11 **(1) UP TO \$2,500 FOR EACH VIOLATION;**
- 12 **(2)** NOT MORE THAN \$50,000 TOTAL FOR ANY SINGLE 13 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING; AND
- 14 (3) Assessed with consideration given to the
- 15 WILLFULNESS OF THE VIOLATION AND THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE EXISTENCE
- 16 OF THE VIOLATION WAS KNOWN TO THE VIOLATOR BUT UNCORRECTED BY THE
- 17 VIOLATOR.
- 18 (D) PENALTIES COLLECTED BY THE FOUNDATION UNDER THIS SECTION
- 19 SHALL BE PAID INTO THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION
- 20 Fund established under § 2–505 of this subtitle.
- 21 (E) THE FOUNDATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 22 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
