1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation – Imposition of Civil Penalties by Board of Trustees – Authorization

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the board of trustees of the Maryland Agricultural 5 Land Preservation Foundation to impose certain penalties on owners of certain 6 property for certain violations under certain circumstances; establishing that 7 each day a violation occurs is a separate violation; establishing certain notice 8 and hearing requirements; requiring the Foundation to provide an alleged 9 violator a reasonable time to correct the alleged violation; establishing certain maximum penalties for certain violations; requiring the imposition of penalties 10 to be assessed in accordance with certain considerations; requiring certain 11 penalties to be deposited into the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation 12 13 Fund; requiring the Foundation to adopt certain regulations; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the authority of the board of 14 trustees of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation. 15

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 **(1)** (A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES AVAILABLE AT LAW OR 4 IN EQUITY AND AFTER AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING, THE BOARD OF 5 TRUSTEES OF THE FOUNDATION MAY IMPOSE A PENALTY ON AN OWNER OF 6 PROPERTY THAT IS SUBJECT TO AN EASEMENT GRANTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE 7 FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, ANY REGULATION 8 ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-504 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OR AN EASEMENT 9 ACQUIRED BY THE FOUNDATION.
- 10 (2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION OCCURS IS A SEPARATE VIOLATION 11 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
- 12 (B) BEFORE TAKING ANY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE FOUNDATION SHALL PROVIDE THE ALLEGED VIOLATOR WITH WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION AND, AN OPPORTUNITY FOR AN INFORMAL MEETING, AND A REASONABLE TIME TO CORRECT THE ALLEGED VIOLATION.
- 16 (C) THE PENALTY IMPOSED ON A PERSON UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL 17 BE:
- 18 **(1) UP TO \$2,500 FOR EACH VIOLATION;**
- 19 **(2) NOT MORE THAN \$50,000 TOTAL FOR ANY SINGLE** 20 **ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING; AND**
- 21 (3) ASSESSED WITH CONSIDERATION GIVEN TO THE 22 WILLFULNESS OF THE VIOLATION AND THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE EXISTENCE 23 OF THE VIOLATION WAS KNOWN TO THE VIOLATOR BUT UNCORRECTED BY THE 24 VIOLATOR.
- 25 (D) PENALTIES COLLECTED BY THE FOUNDATION UNDER THIS SECTION
 26 SHALL BE PAID INTO THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION
 27 FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 2–505 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 28 (E) THE FOUNDATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 29 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 30 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be</u> 31 <u>construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have</u> 32 <u>any effect on or application to any violation occurring before the effective date of this</u> 33 Act.
